Ministry Training Institute

The Ministry Training Institute (MTI) is an Evangelism, Youth Ministry and Missions Training Ministry of the Association Free Lutheran Bible School (AFLBS) in Minneapolis. The purpose of MTI is to train believers for the mission of furthering the Gospel of Jesus Christ by serving in congregations or as a missionary in another culture or place.

We desire to equip Christians to serve and love the people to whom God sends them, to teach sacrifice and service in the context of a practical work experience on location, and to experience the dynamic process of mentorship under trained leaders. MTI is a Biblical training center for men and women with three main tracks of study:

- ▶ Youth Ministry
- ▶ Missions/Cross-Cultural Ministry
- ▶ Mission Aviation Ministry

Through the one year of intensive study and internship, students learn to share the Gospel directly and indirectly in their roles as youth workers, short and full-term missionaries, children's ministry, mission aviation, or as parish builders. Young students out of high school are required to first attend AFLBS for two years. We also invite adults who have previously had some Biblical training. All applicants will be individually interviewed to be accepted into the MTI program.

Academically Distinctive

The two-year Bible track includes courses from Genesis to Revelation plus related studies in evangelism, discipleship, missions, prayer, apologetics, church history, music, and various other topics. Our pastor professors work diligently to provide the best Biblical training on a deeply personal level for each student. Many credits are accepted by major colleges.

The beautiful 25 acre campus is located on the shores of Medicine Lake in the northwest Minneapolis suburb of Plymouth. Classes are offered each morning from eight to noon.

Tradition of Music Excellence

Our music at AFLBS has a long tradition of excellence and has always held a prominent place. The music teams perform and minister to congregations, nursing homes, campus chapel, special events, and summer camps.
